



INSTALLING THE REMOTE CONTROL BATTERIES

Insert 2 batteries into the remote control (type AAA 1,5 V – provided).


Remove the battery cover from the remote control and put 2 \times AAA size batteries inside the compartment.

The diagram inside the battery compartment shows the correct way to install the batteries. Ensure you do not use batteries after date of expiration. (Danger of leakage)

HDMI-CEC - COMMON STB and TV TURN ON/OFF.

It provides controlling of turning on/off functionality via **(**0) button on STB remote control. To do that TV has to support HDMI-CEC functionality.

CEC - Consumer Electronic Control

How to do that:

- 1. Set up HDMI-CEC functionality (support) in TV menu (it can be named various names by various producers for example Anynet (Samsung), Bravia Sync (SONY), Simplink (LG).)
- 2. Set up in STB menu Other settings HDMI-CEC settings turn On/Off control On.



Following this procedure and pressing the button displays turn on/off possibilities with 5 seconds countdown.



Button (b) on STB remote control performs also turning TV and STB back on.

TV IN MOBILE, TABLET AND PC - JUICE TV ANYWHERE.

Juice TV Anywhere device provides TV channels watching on devices such as mobile, tablets or pc. Juice TV Anywhere connects to one of the available USB ports on STB.





As soon as Juice TV Anywhere device is detected, enter into STB menu - Settings/TV Anywhere and insert activation key you have received from your television service provider.





Select your own login details for next Juice TV Anywhere use. From this moment the device is active and ready to use. Watching of TV channels on mobile, tablet or pc is performed on web portal provided by your television service provider.



Parental Lock:

The Parental Lock feature allows you to password protect channel or allow access to all menus. Password is created by entering any 10 figures (it might be less figures than 10 but 10 is maximum)

Create a password:

Go to: Menu / Settings / Parental Lock / Password for Settings and Parental lock. Leave Current password blank, Fill in New Password by entering maximum 10 figures password, then to confirm it fill it in again in New Password Again. Save it by pressing Set New Password. If you make a mistake while filling in, press red button on remote control to delete last entered figure.

Change a password:



*ARCHIVE - RECORDING THE PROGRAMS

1. Marking the programs for recording one by one (individually)

Activate Recording options by pressing the EPG button (Electronic Program Guide) on remote control. Use up/down/right/left arrows to navigate through program list in EPG window . The programs you want to record, mark them one by one (individually) by pressing the OK button on remote control. Next to the program name the red spot appears, symbolizing that program is ready for recording. Use the same OK button on remote control to unmark the program, the red spot disappears.

2. Marking the programs for recording as a group

Activate Recording options by pressing the EPG button (Electronic Program Guide) on remote control. Straight after that press red button on remote control and select one of the options:

After saving of periodic recording and connecting external HDD, there is automatic recording of the set program at the real broadcast time.

Cancel periodic recording

4. TimeShift recording

TimeShift functionality provides channel recording from the moment of switching onto the channel.

Wi-Fi adaptor is used for the purpose of:

A. within own network of your television service provider - distribution of audio, video and image datas within one local home network (supports distribution of media datas via DLNA protocol and BitTorrent files playing)







Before you contact your provider regarding any troubles with you set-top box, check these Frequently Asked Questions. You might find you answer right here.

TROUBLE	HELP AND ADVICE
*Set-top box`s display is OFF	- internet cable is disconnected - you might have set Menu/Settings/Other Settings/Standby display/Black Display where set-top box's display is unlit on purpose
Picture on the screen is OK but there is no sound	- double check Menu/Settings/TV Outputs — if all selected options are in compliance with connection of set-top box to your TV (depending on type of your TV) - check the connection of *SCART cable (if you are connected via SCART cable) - volume is down or MUTE button on remote control of set-top box or TV is pressed
No picture	- incorrect setting of TV Outputs on set-top box. Use front panel of set-top box to correct it. Press M button on front panel and use up/down arrow to select the correct type of connection of set-top box to your TV. Confirm it by pressing the OK button on *front panel – set-top box will restart. - incorrect setting of TV Outputs on your TV (depending on type of your TV).
Channel list is empty	- channel list is downloaded automatically once per 24 hours or by unplugging of set-top box from mains lead and plugging it in straight after - double check if set-top box is connected to internet network - it could be causing by connection of a router between set-top box and internet cable – it is necessary to connect internet cable into set-top box directly
No response to remote control	- no remote control batteries in or remote control batteries exhausted - front panel obstructed
Picture freezes	 try to switch to another channel or restart set-top box by unplugging/plugging in from/to mains lead
Square blocks picture	- check if internet cable was not for some reason interrupted or damaged - restart set-top box
*Black&White picture at SCART connection	- check Menu/Settings/TV Outputs/Type of connection. Select SCART CVBS or SCART S-video (depending on type of your TV)
Quality of Picture is not satisfactory	- check if Menu/Settings/TV Outputs are correctly set (depending on type of your TV)
Everything seems to be set correctly, but there are no channels in Channel list	 it could be causing by connection of a router between set-top box and internet cable – it is necessary to connect internet cable into set-top box directly check if diode on WAN port is lit (if it is not, disconnect/connect internet cable)


